Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist Opportunity

Brandon Regional Health Authority is seeking full-time Psychiatrists to provide clinical services to children and adolescents both within a 10 bed Inpatient Program, as well as community-based Outpatient Program.

The Child and Adolescent Treatment Centre is a CCHSA accredited 7-year-old facility providing a comprehensive range of Child & Adolescent services. Programs include a ten bed Inpatient Unit, Day Treatment Program for early and middle-years adolescents, a fully staffed and credentialed School, and an active Outpatient Program. Services are provided through a collaborative model with our 5-region catchment area in Western Manitoba that is also served by trained and experienced Child & Adolescent Community Mental Health Workers.

The Child and Adolescent Treatment Centre operates within a collegial environment and includes a diverse professional workforce including Psychiatrists, Psychiatric Nurses, Psychologists, Social Workers and Occupational Therapists. The facility is a modern stand-alone building located in a predominantly residential area of Brandon in a park like setting and offers an attractive and comfortable workplace and site.

In addition to standard duties, the Program Psychiatrist acts as a member of the Program Leadership Team together with the Program Manager and Nursing Manager to establish clinical and administrative policies and practices and to share in the overall leadership of the service.

Required qualifications:

- FRCP in psychiatry or eligibility for Royal College of Canada certification.
- Current licensure or eligibility for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba.
- Valid driver's licence and vehicle
- Knowledge of the Mental Health Services delivery system program and related community resources
- Ability to respect and promote confidentiality.

The Brandon Regional Health Authority is a fully accredited health system that offers a wide range of health services and programs to the citizens of Brandon, local municipalities and also serves as a regional referral centre to the Western Manitoba area. The Brandon Regional Health Centre has an acute care hospital, ambulatory care and rehab services, a full range of diagnostic services including MRI and Westman Regional Laboratory.

There are over 100 physicians and specialists with admitting privileges at the health centre, as well as numerous medical clinics located throughout the city to meet the needs of residents. Community-based services include Public Health, Home Care, Mental Health, Audiology,

Medical Officer of Health, and the recently opened 7th Street Health Access Centre. There are also five personal care homes and 10-bed supportive housing units within the Brandon area.

Brandon has the advantage of being able to offer the opportunity and sophistication of metropolitan life with a comforted friendliness of small town living, boasting amenities and conveniences generally found in much larger centres without the complexity and strain often associated with larger city life. Brandon is truly the best of both worlds. It is a sports-oriented city full of top-notch recreational facilities ranging from hockey to English equestrian sports.

Brandon is also the regional centre of Western Manitoba with a population of approximately 45,000 residents, located in the southwest area of the province of Manitoba. Brandon, itself, covers approximately 74 square kilometres and is located 197 kms west of Winnipeg and 365 kms east of Regina, and 100 kms north of the United States border.
